Spiritual Intent

While we intend to provide recreation and have fun, the primary emphasis of our Family Vacation Bible School (FVBS) is teaching the Bible. Our Bible class teachers and staff are committed to teaching the plan of salvation found in the New Testament, in passages such as Matthew 28:18-20, Romans 10:17, Hebrews 11:6, Acts 2:38, Matthew 10:32 and Romans 6:1-4. While at FVBS, a young person may decide to obey the gospel plan of salvation and become a Christian. We would like parents to be aware that the staff will first:

Determine whether this young person is a valid candidate for baptism:

- ❖ one who has reached the age of accountability
- ❖ one who understands the New Testament teaching of salvation
- ❖ one who is making an honest response not based purely on emotion or “following the crowd”

If it is decided that the student is indeed a valid candidate, we will first make every effort to have the student contact his or her parents to inform them of their decision. However, please be aware that our priority will be to carry out the student’s wishes to be baptized. Please discuss this subject with your children before they come to FVBS. While we understand that parents may want to be present for this important event in their children’s life, we also want to avoid situations where we delay something as serious as a baptism (Matthew 24:42-44 and Acts 8:36-38).

Rules and Regulations

Parents: Please ensure that your child understands and complies with these rules and instructions regarding what to bring and what NOT to bring as listed below.

- 1) **Students must abide by ALL rules. Violation of any one or more of these rules MAY be considered grounds for dismissal from the FVBS session. The decision authority is the camp director. If dismissed, parents will be immediately notified and the camper promptly sent home.**
- 2) All students must stay on the church grounds at all times unless approved by the camp director or an assistant director.
- 3) Students should strive to keep the proper mood and spirit of the occasion at all times during FVBS. This refers to proper conduct at all times and includes observing reverence during classes, devotionals and worship and showing respect to other students and to counselors, cooks, nurses, directors and other FVBS staff.
- 4) All students will participate in FVBS programs, functions and activities unless otherwise approved by the director or an assistant director.
- 5) Attendance at all devotionals is mandatory, unless approved by the FVBS director.
- 6) Fireworks, knives, guns or weapons of any kind will NOT be allowed on the premises, including inside of vehicles located on the premises.
- 7) Tobacco products, alcoholic beverages and non-prescription drugs are not allowed. Prescription drugs must be given to the camp director or designated staff for safekeeping and dispensing at the proper time.
- 8) Pets and off-road recreational vehicles are not allowed on the premises.
- 9) Water guns and water balloons are not allowed but may be used in activities and provided by the Activities Director.
- 10) Electronic equipment like cell phones, radios, tape/CD players will not be permitted.
- 11) Automobiles brought to camp will be parked in the parking lot and will not be moved during FVBS unless approved by the director or an assistant director.
- 12) Littering of church grounds, damage to or destruction of our grounds, facilities or natural features in any manner is prohibited.
- 13) Boys are NOT allowed in designated girl's areas at any time! Girls are NOT allowed in the designated boy's area at any time! Violation of this rule will result in automatic dismissal from FVBS. This includes electronic media. (VCR, Camcorder, Cameras, Two-way radios, cell phones, etc.)
- 14) Students are not allowed outside of the building unless approved by a director or their senior counselor.
- 15) Affection toward the opposite sex will be limited to holding hands.



Rules and Regulations (continued)

- 16) Profanity, abusive language or fighting will NOT be allowed.
- 17) Students must dress in a manner consistent with Christian ideals at all times. **Knee-length shorts will be permitted. Shorts should be knee length or longer.** Dresses must be at or below the knee. The camp director will resolve any questions about the appropriateness of student attire. (Shorts, capris and clam-diggers are allowed at the discretion of the camp director/counselors.)
- 18) Shoes shall be worn at all times outside of the building. Closed Toe shoes are highly recommended.
- 19) Campers must be keep his/her surrounding area neat and clean at all times.
- 20) Meals will not be missed unless approved by the camp director or an assistant director.
- 21) All injuries, no matter how minor, must be reported immediately to the camp “nurse”, director or assistant director.
- 22) Visitors are welcome as participants that are willing to abide by all of the rules previously stated.

WHAT YOU ARE ENCOURAGED TO BRING

- 1) Bible (King James, New King James, ESV, or American Standard 1901 versions only please) plus a pencil and notebook.
- 2) Sturdy play shoes (*Note: new shoes may cause blisters*).
- 3) Sunscreen.

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- 1) Halter tops, tank tops, fishnet tops or shirts, immodest clothing (no bikinis, two-piece girls or women’s swimsuits allowed), or immodest clothing of any kind.
- 2) Tobacco, alcohol or illicit drugs of any kind.
- 3) Guns, knives, axes, fireworks or any such like item.
- 4) Magazines or any other material that is distracting
- 5) Two-way Radios and cell phones – Radios and phones brought will be given to given to the director and they will be returned at the close of camp.

Authorization, Release and Indemnity Agreement

State of Texas ~ KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That I (we), the undersigned are the father and mother (or legal guardian) of the above-named minor, hereinafter referred to as "Camper".

That for the purpose of enabling the child to attend Central church of Christ of Pflugerville Family Vacation Bible School Day (hereinafter referred to as "Camp") located on 13213 Old Gregg Lane, I (we) do hereby agree that Camper may attend and participate in the activities of the Camp under the supervision of the officials of the Camp and will abide by the rules of the Camp and Sponsors. That I (we) do further agree to forever release, acquit, discharge and covenant to hold harmless Central church of Christ of Pflugerville, its successors and assigns, the Central church of Christ of Pflugerville and other participating Churches of Christ as sponsors of the Camp (hereinafter known as "Sponsors"), of and from any and all actions, causes of action, claims, demands, damages, costs, loss of services and compensation on account of or in any way growing out of any loss or injury that may be sustained by Camper and also all claims or rights of action for damages while Camper may hereafter have arising from Camper's attendance at the Camp including any and all claims for damage of injury arising from the negligence of the Camp or any of its employees, agents, directors and/or volunteers. We further promise to bind ourselves, jointly and severally, and repay to the said Central

church of Christ of Pflugerville, its successors and assigns, any sum of money that the Camp may hereafter be compelled to pay to or on behalf of Camper because of any accident or injury arising out of Camper's attendance at the Camp.

I (we) further acknowledge that the Camp and Sponsors will rely upon the Acknowledgment, Release and Indemnity Agreement in allowing Camper to attend the Camp.

Authorization for Medical Treatment

Furthermore, if my (our) child (camper) becomes ill or is injured while at camp, I (we) authorize the camp nurse or an individual under the direction of the camp director and staff to provide necessary care to my (our) child. I (we) recognize that the care may include basic first aid, administration of medications (i.e. labeled prescription medications and appropriate over-the-counter medications including (but not limited to acetaminophen, ibuprofen, Pepto-Bismol) and more advanced emergency care if necessary. I (we) further authorize the camp director or designated individuals to seek further medical treatment when and where appropriate and to release appropriate medical information regarding my (our) child to individuals providing medical care or third-party payers.

As the parent(s) or legal guardian(s), I (we) have provided to the camp director or staff appropriate medical information including known allergies, medical history and currently prescribed medications and treatments. Finally, I (we) authorize the publication of photographs of my child.
